Dear Parents/Guardians,

Enclosed please find the information concerning New Summit's summer school program. Summer school classes are offered for students who need to repeat courses or who wish to take courses to advance. A traditional course outline is followed during summer sessions.


The attached application and permission forms must be signed by your child's school principal or counselor. These forms must be completed and returned to New Summit School by the registration deadline, June 2, 2009. Fees must accompany registration forms. Class decisions depending on registration will be determined on June 3rd with teachers and students being notified that day.

Each high school course costs \$450.00 for one carnegie unit, payable at registration. On-line classes will require a registration fee of \$75.00 in addition to the \$450.00 fee. The Summer School session will begin June 4, 2009 and run through July 9, 2009. Classes for grades 9-12 will begin at 8:00 a.m. and dismiss at 12:30 p.m. each day. An afternoon session for on-line classes will begin at 12:30 p.m. and conclude at 3:30 p.m.


